

## **VERRUCA-FREEZE®**

For Removal of Warts, Skin Tags & Other Benign Skin Lesions

## **How to Use**



OR



 Select Bud Applicator: For Use on bony surface area or areas where a tight seal with a cone cannot be achieved. CryoBuds™available in three sizes (small, medium and large).



Do not insert the CryoBud™ into the canister.





- By holding the canister in one hand and the CryoBud™ in the other, apply gentle pressure to the trigger nozzle and lightly spray the CryoBud™. Saturate the bud to its first drip point.
- Place bud directly onto the lesion and hold firmly for 20 - 25 seconds. Remove the bud. An ice ball appears.



4. Allow a thaw time of approximately 40 seconds, no more than 55 seconds, depending on the size of the lesion. CryoBuds™ are not interchangeable between patients. Discard after use.

 Select Limiting Cone: For Use on Fleshy Surface area. Available in five sizes: 12mm, 9mm, 7mm, 5mm and 3mm

Create a tight seal around the lesion and hold firmly.



Spray cryogen at a 45° angle against the inside of the cone wall for approximately 3 - 6 seconds. Accumulate approximately 1/8th inch (3mm) of cryogen into the cone.





- Allow cryogen to completely evaporate or boil off for approximately 20 - 25 seconds. Remove the cone. An iceball appears.
- Allow a thaw time of approximately 40 seconds, no more than 55 seconds, depending on the size of the lesion.

If thaw time exceeds 55 seconds, place hand over lesion to prevent over-freezing.

Limiting cones are reusable and can be cleaned using a sterilizing solution.
